

Mason Publishing Scholarship

The AV and MJ Mason Trust offers an annual scholarship for students studying publishing at tertiary level in New Zealand.

This scholarship was established by the late Andrew Mason, former literary editor of the *New Zealand Listener* and a highly respected book editor. It also acknowledges Andrew Mason's father, Malcolm Mason, who was involved in publishing as chair of Reed Publishing in the 1960s and 1970s and was the author of several books and many newspaper opinion pieces.

The scholarship is awarded on the basis of financial need and is aimed at students who would otherwise not be able to study publishing.

The scholarship aims to cover at least 75% of the tuition fee for one student studying full time.

Payments will be made in two instalments, one in February and one in July, on confirmation of participation and progress in the course of study.

Recipients are expected to report to the Trustees about their year of study at the end of the academic year. There is no requirement to account for how the scholarship is spent.

Priority will be given to students who would not be able to commence or complete their study without the scholarship. If no applicant demonstrates particular financial need, the scholarship may be awarded on the basis of merit, or may not be awarded in any particular year.

Applications are to be made directly to the AV and MJ Mason Publishing Trust and must be received by 15 January for the ensuing academic year.
