# Fees and dates for 2026

## Medical and travel insurance

International students (including group students) must have appropriate and current medical insurance while in Aotearoa New Zealand. The cost of insurance for a full-time student is:

- One trimester: \$408 NZD
- Two trimesters (one year): \$816 NZD

## Accommodation information

If it is your first time coming to Aotearoa New Zealand, we strongly recommend homestay accommodation for you. Homestay accommodation gives students a caring, supportive, and secure environment to live and study in. It is also a great way to practice your English, and experience life in Wellington and all of Aotearoa New Zealand.

## Homestay accommodation

You will need to book a homestay at least 4 weeks before arriving in Aotearoa New Zealand. Included in a homestay is:

- A welcoming environment
- Fully-furnished room and bedding
- Laundry facilities available for you to use
- Three meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) provided on weekends; breakfast and dinner provided on weekdays
- Reasonable use of internet, electricity and water.

Accommodation Placement Fee (non-refundable)	\$310 NZD
Homestay Fee (weekly)	\$340 NZD

You will be required to pay a minimum of four weeks homestay. After the four-week period the homestay becomes a private arrangement with your host.
