A Bachelor's degree or postgraduate qualification in business or related subject with a minimum B grade average, or have the acquired skills and knowledge through relevant work or professional experience.

English language entry

IELTS (Academic) score of 6.5 with no band score lower than 6.0 or equivalent.

Tuition fee

MASTER OF PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE

Choose the online-to-campus pathway now to keep work and life on track, then complete on campus in New Zealand – see the better value in your personalised study and fees plan.

Start your Master of Professional Practice (180 credits) by completing the first 60 credits online from anywhere in the world, fitting study around your personal and professional commitments. You'll then transition to New Zealand to complete the final 120 credits on campus—via a thesis, praxis research project, or professional practice project—with supervision, industry and community engagement, and face-to-face mentoring that turn professional questions into applied outcomes.

You may tailor your degree with an endorsement in Education or Leadership. Education develops capability in curriculum design, teaching practice, assessment, and learner outcomes across professional settings; Leadership builds advanced skills in leading teams, strategy, and change in complex organisations. Choose the endorsement that fits your context and the impact you want to deliver.

Academic entry requirement

A Bachelor's degree or equivalent with a 'B' grade average at Level 7 and evidence of relevant practice in a related professional field.

English language entry

IELTS (Academic) score of 6.5 with no band score lower than 6.0 or equivalent.
