

Ākonga Māori and Pacific looking to learn a trade can apply for a Māori and Pasifika Trades Training (MPTT) scholarship to cover full fees and course-related costs.

### Tautoko while studying

Māori and Pasifika Trades Training scholarship ākonga are supported at both Whitireia Porirua and Petone campuses through the Tamaiti Whāngai team.

The Tamaiti Whāngai team will support you with mentoring, goal setting, pastoral and cultural support. You'll have the opportunity to get your drivers licence with support from Te Rūnanga o Te Āti Awa. The dedicated Tamaiti Whāngai Job Brokers have close links with employers and industry and can connect you with possible apprenticeship and/or employment opportunities.

### **Job Brokers**

### Scholarship criteria

You need to meet the entry requirements for the programme you are enrolling in and be:

## KOTULAKO

Many of our programmes have options for you to study flexibily, allowing the freedom to learn and manage other life commitments. Each programme on our website lists what study options are available.

### **Full-time learning**

Most of our programmes are offered as full-time enrolment. Full-time study includes on-campus study, remote or distance (online) learning, studying as part of a work placement and/or self-directed study. All this information is included on the relevant programme pages on our website.

### Part-time learning

Programmes that enable part-time learning allow you to complete your chosen course of study over a longer period of time. This allows the flexibility to study while managing other commitments. Depending on the programme, part-time options can range between 1-6 years.

### **Blended learning**

Blended learning, allows you to study both on-campus and off-site, completing online tutorials. Programmes with blended learning normally require you to come on to campus to complete block courses during set times, do night classes or spend a dedicated day on campus. The rest of a blended learning programme is taught online, allowing you to complete your programme while balancing your time amongst work, study, and life commitments.

### Distance learning

A small number of our programmes are fully online so that you can study in your own time wherever you are based, but you should expect that most of your time will be online with others.

### Hyflex learning

Hyflex learning enables you to choose how you study. Whether you're already working or are studying full-time, you have the power to choose the balance between study and life. If you're a student who is already working in a relevant workplace, you may have the opportunity to choose the courses that align to your skills and work. You'll also get the choice in how you engage with the programme. Hyflex offers options for learning on-campus, in-person, remotely while the classes are in session, or retrospectively, whenever you get the time throughout the day. You can choose to study partly or fully online. We tailor the programme to suit how you learn best.

### Short courses and micro-credentials

These bite-sized programmes are an excellent way to learn new skills while not having to commit to full-time learning. These mini programmes are offered multiple times throughout the year and only require a certain number of hours of learning each week to complete. They are designed specifically with flexibility in mind, which means you'll easily be able to fit study around other commitments.

### **Certificates of Proficiency**

Don't want to commit to a full programme but you would like to complete a course from a programme? Whether it be out of interest or just simply professional development, there are a number of programmes where you can just enrol in a course and gain a Certificate of Proficiency by completing the course assessments. It is a good way to gain knowledge and skills without having to commit to a whole programme.

### Fees Free Final-Year

If you're new to tertiary studies in 2025, or you've previously studied less than six months at tertiary level, you may qualify for final year fees free study. The fees free programme covers tuition fees, associated mandatory fees, and compulsory student services fees up to \$12,000.

You don't need to do anything to confirm your eligibility until you've finished your final year. However, if you would like to check if you meet the residency and prior study and training criteria before you complete your qualification or programme, you can read the eligibility criteria and find further information on the Fees Free website:

### **Youth Guarantee**

### Are you 16-24 years old?

Youth Guarantee enables you to train feefree for two years in a range of programmes. Youth Guarantee can help cover your fees, course-related costs and travel. This could be ideal if you want to keep learning, but feel that school is no longer for you. Options may include - Automotive, Construction Trades (Carpentry, Electrical, Painting and Decorating, Plumbing, Tiling), Cookery, Hairdressing, and Hospitality.

### **Scholarships**

## NURSING MAORI

### **Bachelor of Nursing Māori**

Level 7

Whitireia Porirua Campus

© Full-time: 3 years

Nau mai, haere mai ki Te Kura Matatini o Whitireia. The Bachelor of Nursing Māori programme is kaupapa Māori orientated to support your learner journey to become a registered nurse with the Nursing Council New Zealand. Your learner journey traverses Te Ao Māori and Te Ao Tapuhi (Nursing). By the end of your three years of study you will be ready to sit your Nursing Council State Examination. You will have demonstrated that you're competent culturally and clinically, and will be able to practice as a Registered Nurse both in Aotearoa and overseas. Fluency in te reo Māori is not essential to apply for this programme.

### Ngā pou o te whare

In the first year of the degree, ākonga connect with their own whakapapa and gain insight into their own identity and belonging within their own whānau, hapū, iwi, community of Aotearoa.

The focus of ākonga learning throughout year one is around the development and application of nursing skills and knowledge in assessing healthy people living at home, with reference to pēpi, tamariki and their whānau, kaumātua and people with a disability.

### Ngā heke o te whare

During the second year, ākonga develop enhanced nursing practice capability, particularly in relation to providing nursing care for pēpi, tamariki and their families in community settings. They enhance their knowledge of mental health, mental illness and the health issues for people with a disability and expand their nursing assessment and intervention skills. By the end of the second year, ākonga can demonstrate that they can safely nurse in predictable and noncomplex situations with minimal supervision.

### Te Tāhūhū o te whare

In the final year, ākonga demonstrate that they are successfully transitioning into the role of Tapuhi/beginning practitioner and are able to confidently move between Māori communities and other health care services in ways that adds value to both.

## E REO MAORI

### New Zealand Certificate in Te Reo (Rumaki Reo Rua)

Level 1

Whitireia Porirua Campus

O Part-time: 1 year

Start your journey in te reo. Gain basic language skills to communicate in te reo Māori in familiar everyday situations. Ideal for beginners or if you want skills and knowledge to support your role in the public or private sectors. You can progress to higher-level programmes to explore te reo further.

### New Zealand Certificate in Te Reo (Rumaki Reo Rua)

Level 2

Whitireia Porirua Campus

O Part-time: 1 year

Extend your language skills to communicate in familiar, everyday contexts as well as in Māori environments where you feel comfortable. Build knowledge for support roles in the public sector or in areas such as tourism, radio, or kōhanga reo.

### New Zealand Certificate in Te Reo (Rumaki Reo Rua)

Level 3

Whitireia Porirua Campus

Sull-time: 18 weeks, part-time: 1 year

Kia kaha te reo Māori! Build your skills and knowledge to an intermediate level in te reo. Use your language skills in a wide range of environments such as whānau, marae, community, workplace or academic contexts. Graduates from this programme will have the skills to confidently communicate in te reo with some independence in everyday settings.

Level 4

URSING PACIFI

### **Bachelor of Nursing Pacific**

Level 7

Whitireia Porirua Campus, Cook Islands\*

Full-time: 3 years

Afio mai, Ulu tonu mai. Turou oro! Throughout your learning journey you'll integrate your knowledge of Pacific communities, cultural practices and nursing knowledge to improve health outcomes for Pacific peoples and the wider Aotearoa New Zealand community and overseas.

On successful completion of this programme graduates receive the Bachelor of Nursing Pacific, are eligible to sit the Nursing Council State Finals, and can apply to enrol in postgraduate programmes of study.

### Year one

Fakavae (Tokelau term of Fakavae, which refers to the concept of foundation).

You will have the opportunity to gain insight into their own Pacific identity, by introducing ākonga to Te Tiriti o Waitangi, Pacific worldviews, and values and models in the context of Aotearoa. You will acquire core communication skills and foundational nursing skills which you will demonstrate in a diverse range of clinical and cultural learning environments that cover lifespan.

### Year two

Faiā (Samoan term which highlights the importance of upholding respectful relationships)

Year two will build on the foundational knowledge and skills acquired in year one, by displaying the beginning attributes of nursing praxis, such as; effective communication, selfreflection and ability to interpret and make meaning from interactions with others across a variety of health care settings. At a beginning level, using reflection and critical thinking, you can facilitate decision making in response to interpretation from a nurse context.

### Year three

Turanga Neti (Cook Islands, refers to the position, status and responsibilities of the nursing profession)

By year three, you will be able to demonstrate that you are successfully transitioning out of your 'student role' and into the role of a beginning practitioner. You will confidently be able to move between their Pacific communities and the world of non-Pacific health care services in ways that add value to both. In year three, you will have become proficient in your ability to integrate nursing knowledge into professional practice. This includes the capability to demonstrate sound judgement, decision making, reflection, evaluation, professional conduct and best practice as a beginning nurse clinician.

### New Zealand Diploma in Youth Work

Level 6

Whitireia Porirua Campus

Tull-time: 2 years, part-time available

Start your career in youth work by studying the New Zealand Diploma in Youth Work. Learn the skills that will help the young people in our community to grow to be the best version of themselves.

This programme aims to develop competent youth practitioners and meet the standards as set by Ara Taiohi.

### Year one

Provides a strong foundation of knowledge, self, values, cultural awareness, ethics, legislation, and personal and professional reflection skills in a professional setting.

### Year two

Consolidates year one learning and the focus shifts to the integration of theory, practice and ethics in youth work.

### Practicum

The practical work-based components of the programme prepare ākonga for work as youth practitioners who integrate positive youth development principles into their practice.

### Bachelor of Counselling and Addictions Practice

Level 7

Whitireia Porirua Campus

O Full-time: 3 years, part-time available

Make a difference with a career in counselling and addictions. Develop skills that are valued in a range of social occupations; including roles as addictions practitioners or counsellors.

This programme develops graduates who can practice professionally according to the values and ethics of the Addiction Practitioners' Association, Aotearoa-New Zealand (DAPAANZ) and the New Zealand Association of Counsellors (NZAC).

### Year one

Introduces ākonga to a range of counselling approaches and concepts of mental health, society, social justice, Tiriti o Waitangi, indigenous and various cultural knowledge, theories and models that impact themselves, clients, and the community.

### Year two

Enables ākonga to interpret, integrate and develop a range of professional practice skills, utilising theories, models, assessment, supervision, self-care, ethics, research, and legislative knowledge in a placement setting.

### Year three

Consolidates years one and two and strengthens theoretical knowledge, counselling, mental health, intervention planning, practice application, reflection, and the integration and application into their last placement. It also serves as the eligible platform to apply for provisional membership/registration with DAPAANZ, NZAC and the New Zealand Christian Counsellors Association.

### Bachelor of Youth Development (RPL Pathway)

Level 7

Whitireia Porirua Campus

Complete a degree with your experience recognised. Do you have the NZ Diploma in Youth Work (Level 6), industry registration (Koruwai Tupu) and/or five+ years in a youth worker position? If any of these apply to you, you may be eligible to have your prior learning recognised for up to two years of the Bachelor of Youth Development. To find out if you are eligible, you will need to have an initial discussion with kaimahi to check what will be needed to have your experience recognised before completing your study on a full-time or part-time basis.

### **Bachelor of Social Work**

Level 7

Whitireia Porirua Campus

S Full-time: 4 years, part-time available

Studying the Bachelor of Social Work degree will equip you with the knowledge and skills to work with individuals, whanau/ families, and communities to address social problems and promote well-being. You'll be able to advocate for social justice, support people in crisis, and help them access resources and services when needed.

This programme is designed to meet the professional and educational requirements of the Social Workers Registration Board (SWRB) and in doing so provides those who choose to study at Whitireia with a sound social work education, a recognised qualification, and a pathway to higher qualifications.

### Year one

The foundations for social work education are established and begin to be contextualised. Akonga start to develop an awareness of their personal practice base and can see how theory informs social work practice and can apply knowledge of professional and legal responsibilities.

### Year two

Ākonga understanding of social worker identity opens them to communication skills for different audiences, gain knowledge and practices that inform them of safe social work practices and become more aware of the social work context they are developing.

### Year three

Year three continues to prepare ākonga to develop more specialist social work knowledge and skills. It contains the first 12 weeks of social work field placement where they will be aware of themselves and 'others' with whom they engage on placement. Maintaining safe practice for themselves, their clients, and the organisation by drawing on their knowledge of ethics, law, and social work practice theory.

### Year four

Ākonga are enabled to prove the competencies expected of them as new social work practitioners. Take responsibility for their actions, are informed by the many dimensions of social work knowledge, and can critically reflect on their actions and responses, as well as those of others. They are able to demonstrate an integrated philosophical approach to, and critical thinking about, Te Tiriti o Waitangi in a variety of work situations, ranging from the governance and management levels of an organisation to their own personal supervision and practice theory with clients in their last 12 weeks of placement.

### New Zealand Certificate in Health and Wellbeing - Social and Community Services (Community Health Work)

- Level 4
- Whitireia Porirua Campus, blended
- © Full-time: 1 year, part-time available

Become a community health worker in Well Child/Tamariki Ora. Develop skills in building relationships, leadership, and cultural inclusivity. This qualification is for those working in the programme and is delivered in partnership with Plunket.

The programme is delivered using blended learning which includes face-to-face, online learning, and work integrated learning, where you will put the theory you have learnt into practice.



In year one, ākonga learn clinical skills in our simulation suites, as well as attend clinical placements in rest homes and community settings. In years two and three, ākonga will attend clinical placement blocks, in a variety of clinical settings.

### Year one

Has a primary healthcare focus. Ākonga are supported to become akonga nurses by gaining knowledge focused on concept-based learning - nursing theory and research, nursing science, Te Tiriti o Waitangi, cultural safety, sociology, communication and assessment.

### Year two

Akonge have become an independent learner and is ready to add to the concepts gained through on-site workshops and contextbased learning, with a focus on national health trends and simulated learning experiences.

### Year three

Nursing akonga consolidate practice and theory knowledge in preparation for undertaking the roles and responsibilities of a registered nurse. Integration of knowledge, focusing on contemporary professional nursing and health issues in the local and global context, enables ākonga to further develop in their clinical judgement, professionalism, and leadership.

In the second semester, ākonga have an extended period in clinical practice to prepare for the Nursing Council State Final Examinations and registered nurse practice.
